



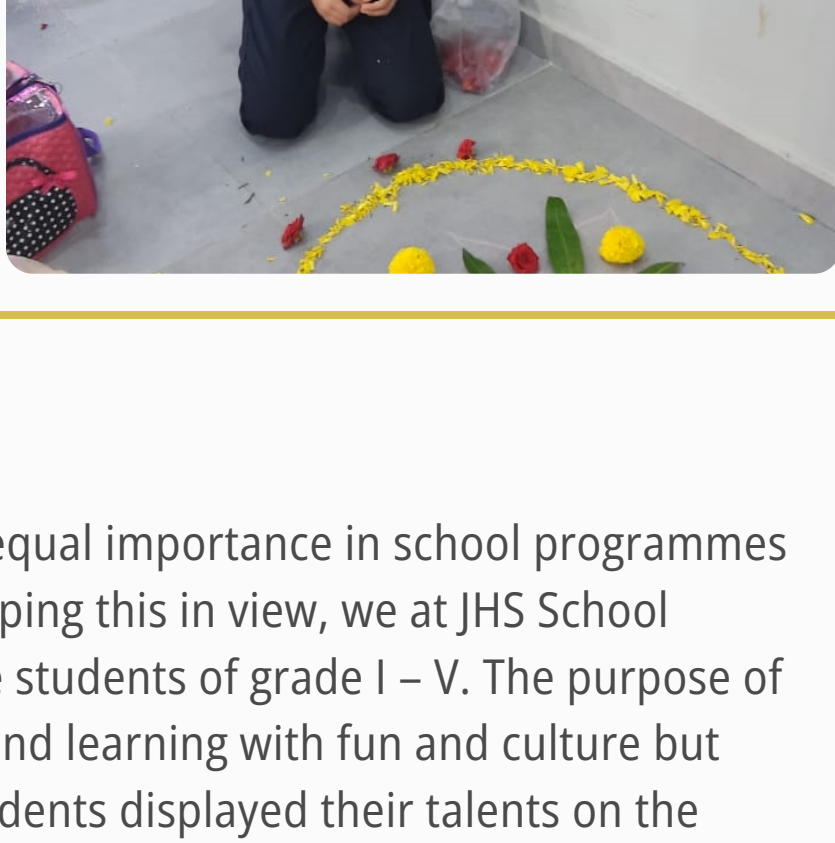
# Introduction

Let's take a glimpse through the exciting events which kept our young and bright minds occupied.

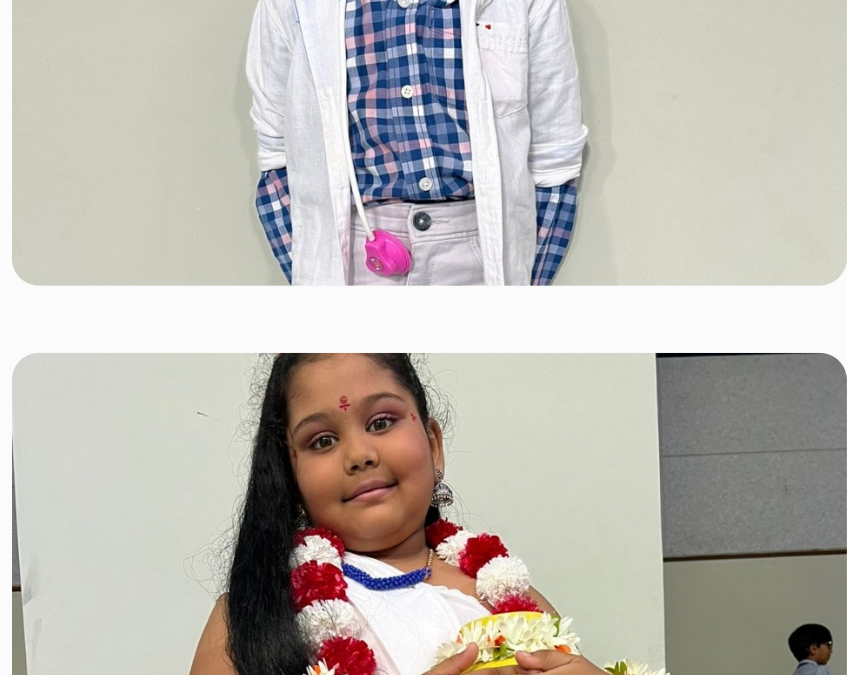
## Rangoli Making Competition

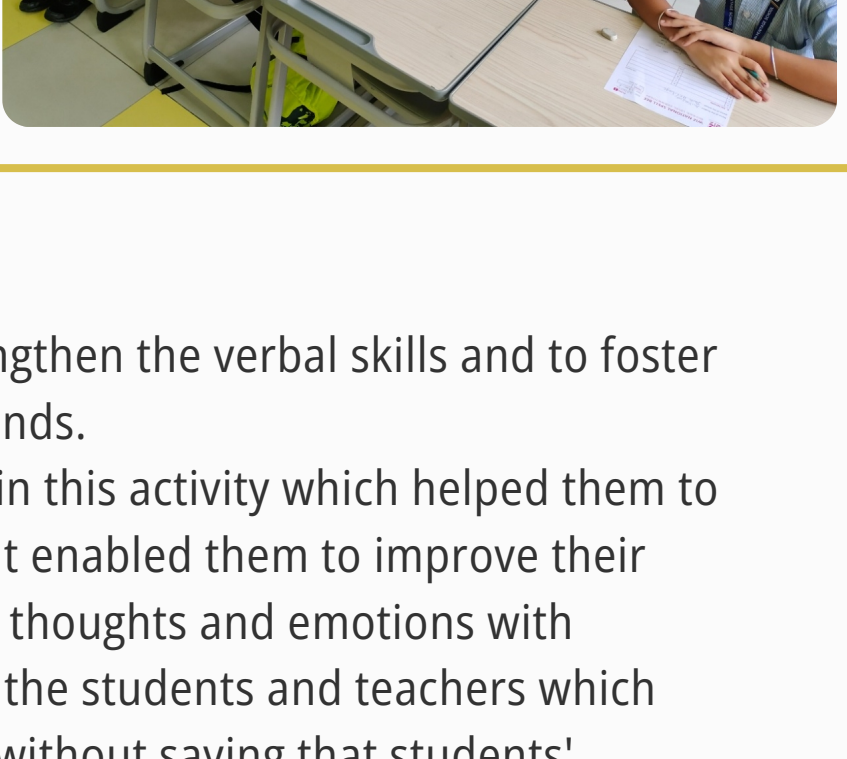
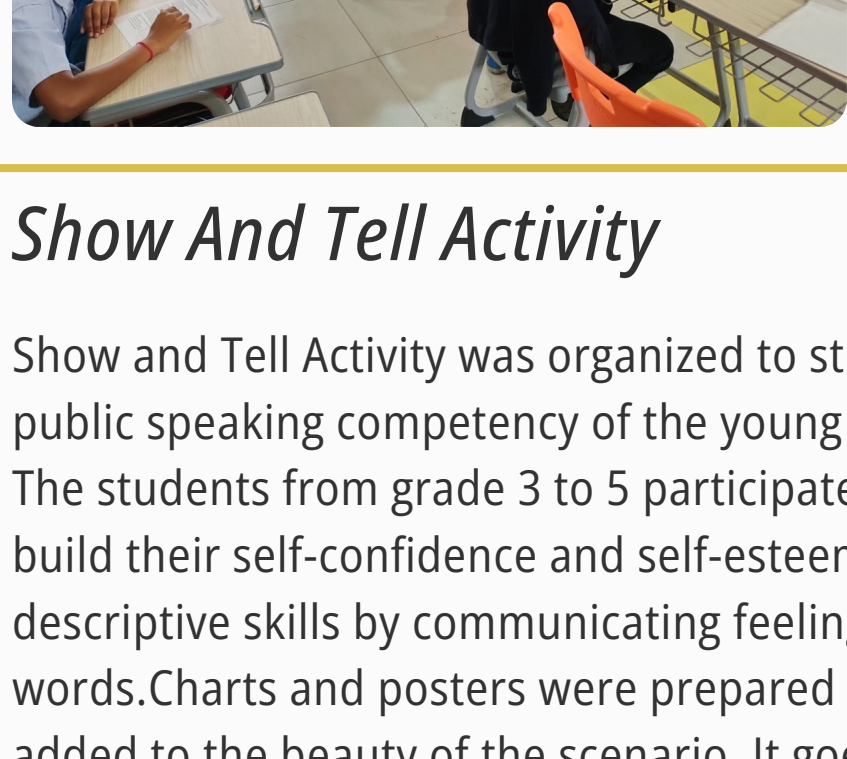


## Spell Bee Competition

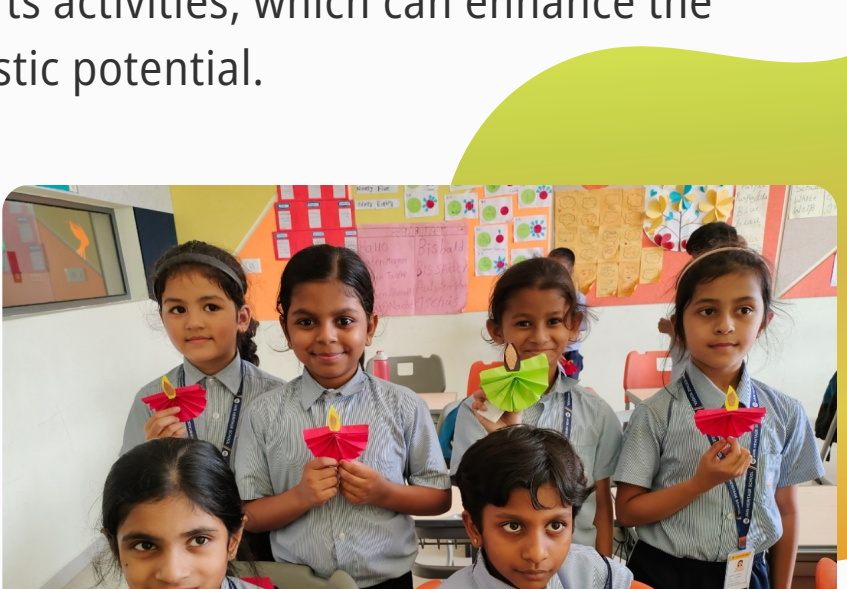
It was an interesting and thrilling experience for the kids sharing their feelings with peers which provided a fun and comfortable learning arena for everyone involved.

#### Art and craft learning at School

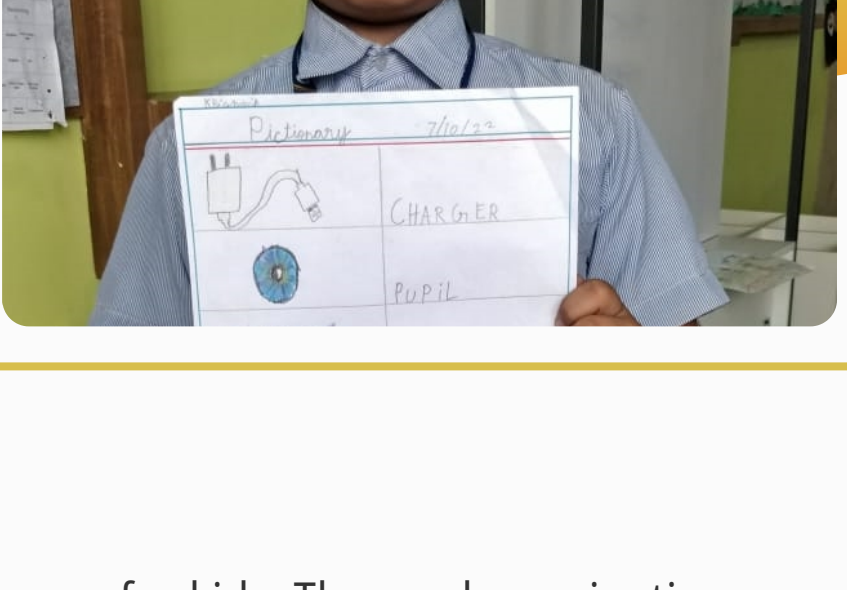
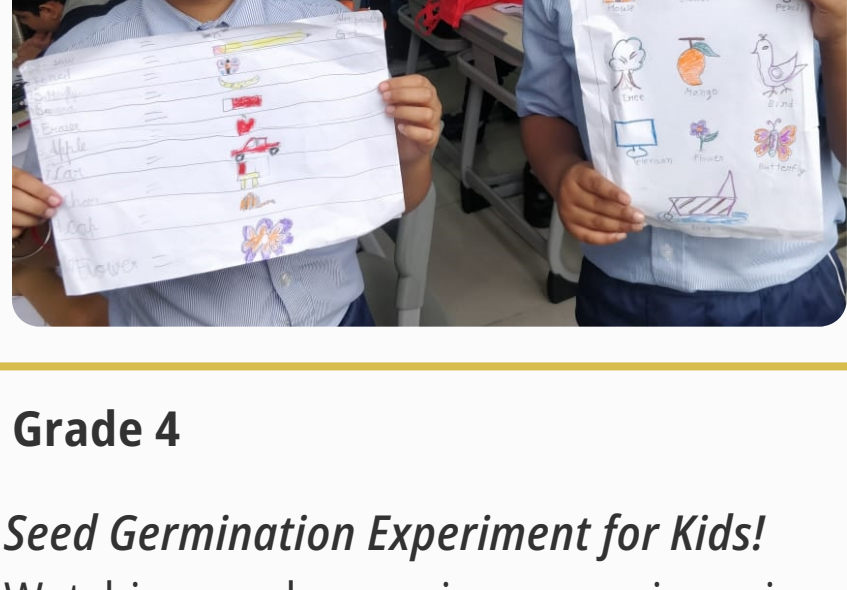

### Grade 3

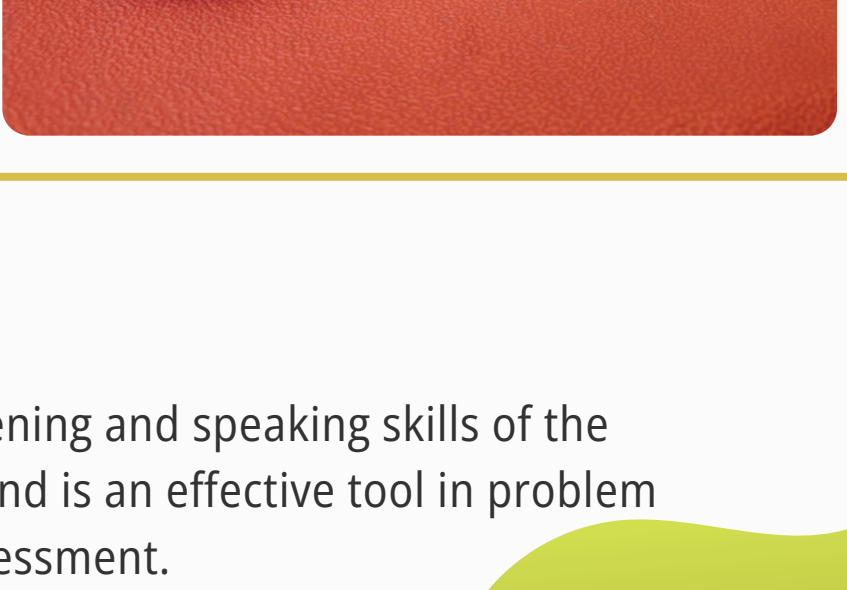
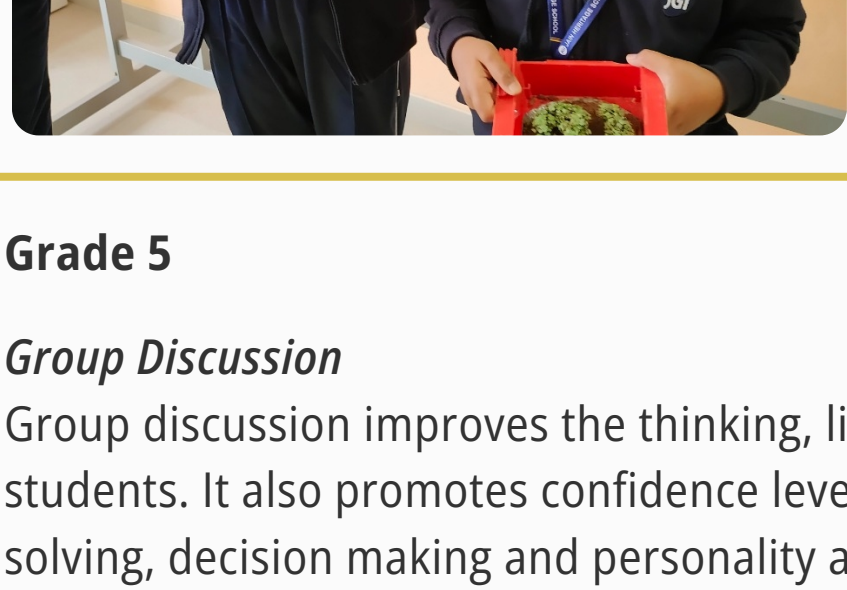
#### Diya Decoration
