Sl. No.	The school is directed to ensure that :
1	The total number of sections of Balvatika shall be restricted to 12 (Four each in Balvatika 1,2 and 3). The total number of sections from classes 1 to 10 shall be restricted to 22. The optimum number of the students shall be restricted to 40 in each section. Any further increase of section shall require prior approval of the Board, subject to compliance with affiliation bye laws and availability of rooms of 500 sq. ft. dimension.
2	Safety features such as fire extinguisher and exhaust fan etc. are not seen in the IC video. The school is required compliance as per the SOP of the Board and submit the videography link within 3 months on SARAS portal.
3	Regular cubicle converted into CWSN toilets which is very narrow and without handrails. Thus, the school is required to construct accessible CwSN with sufficient space on each floor separately for Boys and Girls with handrails on both side of toilet seat (fixed and movable) and proper permanent signage (on the cubicle indicating the floor number) as per norms of RPwD Act and submit the compliance with videography within 3 months on SARAS portal.
4	The school is required to submit the bank statement for salary paid to teachers for last 6 months and teacher wise salary statement within 3 months on SARAS portal.
5	The school is directed to ensure that all essential valid documents are available under the head Mandatory Public Disclosure (as per annexure – IX) on school's website at all time and the link of certificates should be remain functional and submit an analytication in this regard on its letter head duly signed by the principal and manager of the school, and submit the compliance within 3 months on SARAS portal.

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6	The school shall conduct training of its teachers with CoE Bangalore and submit the compliance within 3 months on SARAS portal.
7	As per the recommendation of NEP, the school shall ensure the participation of its students in Structured Assessment for Analyzing Learning (SAFAL), an exam conducted by the Board every years as per the guidelines issued by the Board vide circular no: - Acad-49/2024 dated 26th June 2024.
8	The school shall ensure the implementation of the Holistic Progress Card (HPC) in the school as per the guidelines issued by the Board vide notification no. CBSE/Director (AcadAssessment)/2023 dated 27.12.2023.
9	The school shall ensure to conduct at least 50 hours of Continuous Professional Development (CPD) every year for all the teachers vide notification no. 16/2021 dated 24.09.2023 out of which 25 hours should be from COE Bangalore.
10	The school shall submit an undertaking with regard to uploading all requisite information regarding students, teachers and infrastructure available in the school on the UDISE Portal. The registration of the students in classes IX and XI shall be conditional on the school providing complete information on UDISE.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII, as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

- The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
- The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State
 /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State
 Government concerned.
- The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
- 4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., http://cbseacademic.nic.in/ & http://cbse.nic.in/ for updates.
- The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
- 6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.

 its website.

If the compliance is not submitted with in the stipulated 3 months, the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.
